<p>John 3:16, Romans 8:38-39</p>	<p>God's Love For Us. ¹⁶For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life. // ³⁸For I am persuaded that neither death nor life, nor angels nor principalities nor powers, nor things present nor things to come, ³⁹nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate us from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.</p>
<p>Philippians 4:19; Romans 8:32; Matthew 6:33</p>	<p>His Provision For Our Needs. ¹⁹But my God will supply all of your needs according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus. // ³²He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, how shall He not with Him also freely give us all things? // ³³But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you.</p>
<p>Philippians 4:13; Isaiah 41:10; Isaiah 40:31</p>	<p>His Strength. ¹³I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me.// Fear not, for I <i>am</i> with you; Be not dismayed, for I <i>am</i> your God. I will strengthen you, Yes, I will help you, I will uphold you with My righteous right hand. // ³¹But those who wait on the LORD Shall renew <i>their</i> strength; They shall mount up with wings like eagles, They shall run and not be weary, They shall walk and not faint.</p>
<p>Hebrews 9:27; 2 Corinthians 5:10</p>	<p>We Will Be Judged. ²⁷And as it is appointed for men to die once, but after this the judgment, // ¹⁰For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, that each one may receive the things <i>done</i> in the body, according to what he has done, whether good or bad.</p>
<p>1 John 1:9; 2 Chronicles 7:14</p>	<p>He Can Forgive Our Sins. ⁹If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us <i>our</i> sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. // ¹⁴if My people who are called by My name will humble themselves, and pray and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin and heal their land.</p>
<p>James 4:7; John 10:10</p>	<p>Victory. ⁷Therefore submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you. // ¹⁰The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have <i>it</i> more abundantly.</p>

Philippians 3:20-21; John 14:2-3	Heavenly Citizenship. ²⁰ For our citizenship is in heaven, from which we also eagerly wait for the Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ, ²¹ who will transform our lowly body that it may be conformed to His glorious body, according to the working by which He is able even to subdue all things to Himself. // ² In My Father's house are many mansions; if <i>it were not so</i> , I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. ³ And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, <i>there</i> you may be also.
John 14:27; John 16:33 Philippians 4:6-7	Peace. ²⁷ Peace I leave with you; My peace I give to you; not as the world gives, do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, nor let it be fearful. // ³³ These things I have spoken to you, that in Me you may have peace. In the world you have tribulation, but take courage; I have overcome the world. // ⁶ Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; ⁷ and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.
